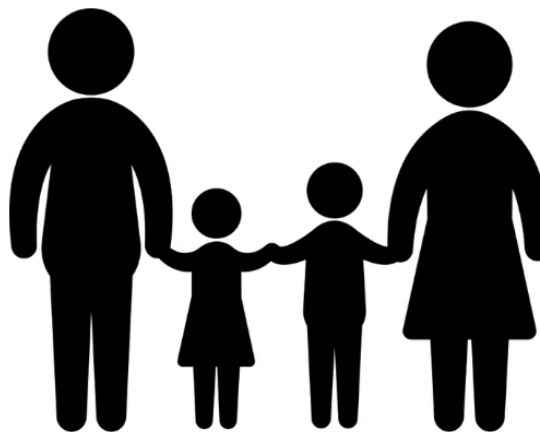

This program is all-inclusive; to accommodate all children aged 5-17 regardless of physical, cognitive, or social limitations. The team, Wood Buffalo Royals, will be part of the Fort McMurray Minor Hockey Association as a non-competitive team.

During ice time we want parents to enjoy watching their kids enjoy the sport as all typical parents get to experience. There will be buddies on the ice to help as well as volunteer coaching staff so they will not be completely on their own. If your child requires 1-1 please come to us and we will accommodate accordingly. Please remember that this will not be a full hockey game experience, it is for the kids to have fun, learn hockey skills to the best of their ability and have the sport camaraderie as a group.

Equipment

Children will be required to wear a minimum of skates/sledges, hockey helmet with face guard, hockey gloves and a stick

If your child is able to wear full hockey gear, that would be preferred

There is some second hand hockey gear available to borrow

Skates and helmets are also available to rent from the Sk8Lab at MacIsland (\$5 for skates, \$2 for helmet)

Sledges available for usage if a family does not have one

Anyone assisting on the ice will also be required to have skates, gloves and a helmet

All ice times will be at MacDonald Island

Dates

There are two free "Come try it out" dates: Oct. 21 & 27 from 12-1pm

You do not have to attend both, but are welcome to if you would like

The season officially starts on Saturday November 9 and will run until the end of March

Ice times will be Saturdays from 3:00-4:15

Registration

You do not need to register until after the "Try it out" dates.
